# **ABoVE SDT Leadership Meeting - 7/2/13**

## **New Business:**

- 1. Full SDT Telecon Agenda
  - a. Discuss the strawman document distributed by Eric K. to the SDT which proposes how to organize the SDT as they move forward. There is a focus on the "changes to ecosystems" portion of the vulnerability diagram and the contents of this area will be used to determine the working groups: vegetation, soil carbon, permafrost and hydrology
  - b. There are two main tasks identified for the SDT during the Fairbanks meeting and they will be discussed during the telecon: Day 1 Identify the key science questions within each of the topic areas (the working groups). Day 2 Use the questions identified during Day 1 to determine the research needed to address the science questions (field data, modeling, remote sensing, socio-economic data, etc.)
    - i. A group on societal interactions/consequences will be integrated with other groups for a time, but then will also break out for a time. It will be important to ensure that research areas integrate societal issues
    - ii. It will be important to recognize that humans have interactions, consequences and responses (human responses feed back into the system)
- 2. Agenda for ABoVE SDT Meeting in Fairbanks
  - a. Day 1 Determine key science questions
  - b. Day 2 Synthesize questions and determine research needed
  - c. Day 3 Discuss study design
    - i. The SDT should consider what research is currently being conducted and what infrastructure is already in place
    - ii. On this day, have the SDT discuss an outline for study design, the timing for the next 2 meetings, and homework assignments for the next two meetings.

#### 3. Data layers

a. An ArcOnline web application is under development to allow SDT members to view data layers relevant to site selection. A demo of this system will be done at the SDT meeting

## 4. Canadian partnerships

a. 3<sup>rd</sup> SDT meeting – There are ongoing discussions to have the 3<sup>rd</sup> SDT meeting in Ottawa. Current issues are arising with timing. The SDT may want to have a September meeting, but Canadian partners may not be prepared for a meeting until October. The last 2 weeks in October could be potentially good weeks.

#### 5. AGU Update

- a. An ABoVE presentation at AGU may be a possibility. One issue is that the ABoVE campaign has not yet fully begun, although the 5 pre-ABoVE projects could be presented. A Townhall session may be more feasible.
- 6. Information on NW Territories trip in August:

a. Eric K. has sent out emails and should have responses in a few weeks, responses he has received seem positive.

## 7. Other business:

- a. Planning for the SDT meeting: There is the potential for a trip to the Bonanza Creek LTER– Eric K. will lead if there is interest
