To volunteer as a judge: (please read carefully – the system is a bit clunky. If you get stuck, feel free to reach out and ask me for help)

- Click on the "Volunteer" link **on the bottom** of the AGU OSPA [homepage](#).
- Log in using the email address and password associated with your AGU membership account.
- Upon entering the system, you will be asked to agree to the OSPA honor code and rules of contest.
- Select presentations to evaluate from the Showcase and Add to your list. **There are a lot here and it can be hard to navigate. I suggest filtering the list by the session #, e.g. B15C, to find the relevant presentation.**
- Presentations can be evaluated beginning 13 December 2021. All evaluations must be submitted by 3 January 2022.
