

The public is invited to view one of the NASA research planes that will be flying over the Northwest Territories as part of the Arctic-Boreal Vulnerability Experiment (ABoVE) to study Arctic and boreal environments.

The G-III aircraft is one of eight that will be flying out of Fairbanks, Alaska, and Yellowknife from May through October.

The ABoVE is a NASA-led, 10-year field experiment to better understand the ecological and social consequences of environmental changes in one of the most rapidly changing regions on Earth.

Satellite, airborne and ground observations across Alaska and Canada will help us better understand the local and regional effects of changing forests, permafrost and ecosystems.

The Governments of Canada, the Northwest Territories, First Nations and Canadian universities have contributed to the planning of the field campaign.
