

Mandate The GRRB is the main instrument of wildlife, fish and forest management in the Gwich'in Settlement Area. The Board acts in the public interest, representing all the parties to the Gwich'in Comprehensive Land Claim Settlement – the Gwich'in, the people of the Northwest Territories, and all Canadians.




## Renewable Resources Councils (RRCs)


### **GRRB Research Mandate**

- 12.8.37 Intention for the board & government to work together
- 12.8.38 Board may participate in research
- 12.8.40 Wildlife research shall directly involve the RRCs
- 12.9.5 Board shall consult regularly with RRCs

#### How?

- Regularly engages RRCs and Gwich'in harvesters
- Provides advice on research activities in the GSA
- Conducts research, provides in-kind or financial support
- Research priority process in place

## **GRRB Research Priority Process**



- Community initiated
- Strong partnerships
- Community collects data
- ▶ Long term dataset (20 years)
- ▶ TK & science integrated
- Used by decision makers

### Gwich'in Harvest Data Collection



- GRRB administers
- RRCs coordinates
- Partnerships
- Statistically sound but relies on harvester participation
- Used by decision makers
